Visit Type (Statewide)	Status
Total Visits	Within Expected Levels
Heat-Related Illness	Currently Elevated Statewide visits spiked on 8/22, when there were 45 visits compared to an average of 1.8 visits per day during the prior week. Daily visits have started decreasing but remain elevated above baseline.
Fire and Smoke Inhalation	Within Expected Levels
Non-Fatal Submersion and Drowning	Slightly Elevated

	There was a small spike in statewide visits on 8/24. There were 5 visits, compared to an average of 1.1 visits per day during the prior week. Visits appear to be related to a shared incident while swimming near a waterfall.
